Stakeholder Consultation Body (SCB) and JARUS meeting

As discussed at the JARUS Plenary Meeting held in Beijing, China, on September 2015, and as part of a close collaboration with Industry, JARUS leadership had its inaugural meeting with the Stakeholder Consultation Body (SCB) on the 1 & 2 December in Washington at the Aerospace Industries Association (AIA) premises.

The goal of this meeting was to launch the SCB and select the chairman and to agree a level of openness and transparency leading to a better understanding of what the process should be for joining the SCB working group members with all those JARUS activities that require support. The SCB will enable several Stakeholder Communities of Interest to get engaged with the JARUS work programme. The JARUS Working Groups have already launched various calls for expertise support in the development of their deliverables.

Mr Roger P. Murry, representing the European Small RPAS Coalition was elected as the chairman of the SCB and he is now setting up the working arrangements of the SCB. We are looking forward to working together with Roger to ensure adequate stakeholder involvement improving our JARUS end products and have a better understanding from an industrial perspective how the RPAS market is developing. It will also enable us to react sooner to new technical developments.

We believe this new corporation between JARUS and the SCB will benefit the RPAS community in safe and efficient RPAS integration.
